About CPL

This statement is made on behalf of CPL, a television production company based in London, producing entertainment, factual entertainment and scripted television programming for UK and SVOD broadcasters as well as programming for Radio. CPL is a subsidiary of Seven One Studios and further information can be found at <https://www.cplproductions.co.uk/> and <https://sevenonestudios.com/>.

CPL’s annual turnover as of its most recent financial year meets the threshold prescribed under Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (“Act”) and as a responsible business committed to protecting people from modern slavery and meeting our obligations under the Act we detail below the policies and procedures adopted by us to comply with the Act.

CPL’s primary place of business is the UK, though filming of various productions may take place in other countries, including Europe and the United States.

CPL’s Suppliers

We use a number of third party suppliers as required by the business, providing both goods and services to our offices as well as on our productions in London and elsewhere. We select our suppliers and business partners carefully based on their expertise and compliance with statutory requirements, including anti-bribery and anti-slavery laws. Our terms of business and contracts include industry-standard terms which comply with best practice and require those we work with to adhere to a required standard and all applicable laws and regulations.

We are not aware of, and have not experienced, any issues of modern slavery in our operation or supply chain and referring to our regular supplier checks we consider the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chain to be low.

CPL’s Policies and Procedures

We have a broad slate of internal company policies including with respect to anti-corruption, whistleblowing and health & safety and include guidance on our production documents issued to all team members on our shoots with respect to modern slavery, including information on how to identify it and how to take action. We regularly review these policies and our related procedures and update documentation and practices as required.
